Speaking the truths (no matter the circumstances) surrounding the epidemic of drug use may be the difference between life and death for someone. In honor of Danny's life, we ask that truth be spread in regards to this epidemic and awareness be raised.

Danny was kind, funny, selfless, and always tried to find the positive in any situation. In turn, doing his best to block out the negatives, which is where his addiction came into play. Drugs offered Danny an escape from his demons he faced throughout his life. Right here in small town USA is heroin laced with fentanyl. To anyone facing this demon, every time you inject, snort or smoke you are playing Russian Roulette with your life. As you hold it in your hand make certain you are ready to meet your maker.
