Garland Gus Robinson was born May 26, 1930, to William Gus and Edith Marie Robinson in Schug Town, Arkansas. He passed peacefully from this life on June 1, 2023, in Paragould. He was 93 years old.

At the young age of 14 he began working hauling soybeans for Robinson Farm. Garland spent over 18 years with Foremost Dairy delivering milk to Paragould, Monette, Leachville and Manila. From 1968-74 he owned Robinson Grocery in Walcott. Later he joined Builders Transport as an owner operator. On the road Garland was known as the “store keeper” later retiring as a dispatcher. He worked from daylight to dark most days to make sure his family had everything they needed.

Although Garland firmly believed you don’t spare the rod, he was the most loving and devoted dad and Papa you could ever know. “I Love You” was not said often however it was spoken in everything he did for his family. He had the personality and natural charisma to make friends no matter the situation, and his laugh was infectious to everyone around him. A man of many traits, he was always “tinkering” with something, fixing something for somebody, or doing something to help someone out. He never met a stranger and would give you the shirt off his back.

Garland was a great man whose impact will be forever felt by his family. He

was a selfless man whose passing leaves an unfillable gap in the hearts of his loved ones. His ability to sacrifice, provide, support, forgive, and love will be forever engrained in everyone he knew.
