Jaime Joanna Lee Walter, 32, passed away peacefully on Friday, January 5th in Memphis, Tennessee. She was surrounded by her closest family and friends. In a final act of kindness, she shared the ultimate gift of life through organ donation, saving 5 others in need.

Jaime was born on May 29, 1991 in Blytheville, Arkansas to John Brockman Walter and Dorothy Yerbey. She was raised by the late Bobbie Walter in cotton fields by the river. A life-long resident of Armorel, she graduated from high school in 2009 with the proud title of "Class Clown." After graduation she attended college to be a dental assistant. Nurturing her love for children, she also spent many years helping her Aunt Bobbie with her in-home daycare. She was of the Catholic faith and a life-long member of Immaculate Conception Church.

Known for her kind and generous heart, Jaime was someone you could always depend on, no matter what. She was extremely loyal to those she loved and cared about. You could always count on her to be there with a listening ear and plenty of unruly advice. Jaime had an iconic sense of humor and never met a stranger. She was well known for telling jokes and pulling pranks, but hated to be the center of attention. Jmee Jo loved spending time with her friends, undisturbed naps, Taco Bell, a cold Coke or Dr. Pepper, Adam Sandler, spontaneous fishing trips (but she was NOT baiting the hook!!),

thrift shopping, helping others, cleaning, talking smack—to put it nicely, and making people smile. She either loved you or she didn't; it was very black and white. Jaime was independent and strong. She could do anything she set her mind on...especially if you told her not to.
