Suzanne was the happiest when she was near the beach. Her favorite place is the Scenic 17-Mile drive in Pebble Beach. If she were not driving that Volkswagen Beetle along the shoreline, she would be walking barefoot in the sand flying a mylar dragon kite.

She was preceded in death by her parents HB and Juanita (Yancey) Bouchillon and her best friend Linda Berry.

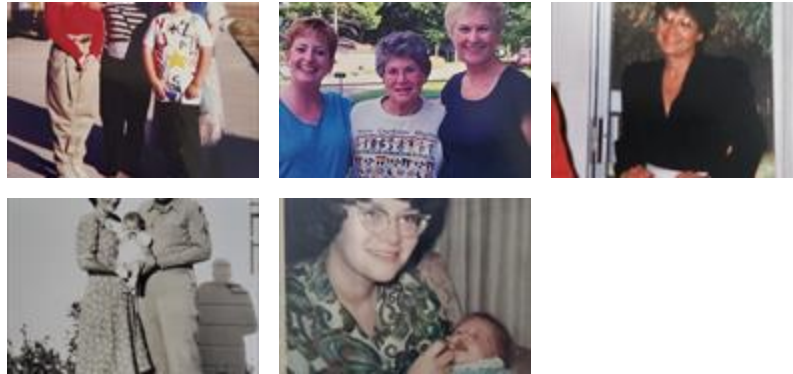
