Jim Ivon Jones of Manila, AR passed from life Friday, November 19, 2021 at Evening Shade, AR. Jim was born October 5, 1964 in Osceola, AR to Wayne Thomas Jones and Margaret (Walker) Jones. He is a lifelong resident of Manila, AR and graduate of Manila High School. He is preceded in death by his mother, father, and his brother Jerry Jones. 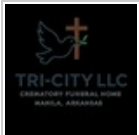
