I'm a woman in need. = W.I.N.

I have rededicated my life = FOR
to God. I'm 100% disabled = GOD

I'm homeless. I'm nearly
50 yrs. old and you are
more than likely asking "How
in the world did I become so
pitiful?" I ask myself the same
question at times. Did it
start when I took my first
drink? or when I got my DUI
and lost my car? or when I took
that pill my docot did not
give me. Does the why really
matter? God knows the why, and

I need to know the why. By my knowing the why was the first step in my walk with God and his fixing me. Because I needed fixing. I was released from jail October 10 back into a society with nothing but what I had on. By December 11th when I got to the WFRM and admitted to God that he was the only one that was going to fix me, my life began to feel worth something, worth living.
