She also leaves behind several nieces and nephews and a host of long-time friends.

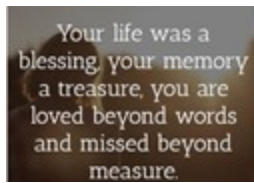
Winnie's final request has been honored by her family having a private Celebration of Life. Expressions of sympathy may be sent directly to her family.

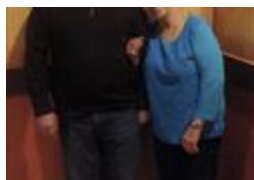
